For example, the teacher gets the students attention by using the "class, class, class" with the response by the students of saying "yes, yes, yes". Anita is using this with success. However, she will want to explore other such techniques as these kinds of things can become old for the students or any one of these can be overused.

Suggestions for Improvement:	This lesson was part of a holiday unit the classroom teacher was implementing and Anita demonstrated her flexibility by jumping in and creating this lesson. She began by reviewing previous learning and then introduced the new learning. Before doing a read-aloud she set a purpose for the students to focus on finding facts within the reading. At the conclusion of the reading she conducted a discussion with the students about the facts that had found and then asked them to write one of those facts on their paper. From there she had a craft type of activity for the students that correlated to the lesson. Research shows us review, setting a purpose, followed by an student activity are components of an effective lesson.
